Parents of children who require their child to be administered prescribed medication at school must complete a written request. The school can provide you with a copy of a request form.

If your child has been prescribed an adrenaline autoinjector, you will need to provide the school with one (and renew prior to expiry date). Each time your child is prescribed a new adrenaline autoinjector the doctor should issue an updated ASCIA Action Plan for Anaphylaxis. It is important that any updated plan is provided to the school.

Yoogali Public School may publish information about your child for the purposes of sharing his/her experiences with other students, informing the school and broader community about school and student activities and recording student participation in noteworthy projects or community service.

GENERAL EXCURSION CONSENT

The General Excursion Consent is intended to cover all such occasions during the period a child is attending Yoogali Young Starters at Yoogali Public School. It includes permission to attend shows by visiting performers, participate in or watch nearby events which involve walking, or, excursions such as a walk to the local park. All activities will be supervised by a teacher and Learning Support Officer and have the approval of the Principal.
